IRISH

Recognised as the original home of whiskey distillation – though hotly contested by Scottish producers – Irish whiskies are smooth, fruity and normally triple-distilled for easy drinking. They're unique for their pure pot still whiskey, which gives it a distinctive spiciness. Bushmills distillery takes the title for the world's oldest, founded in 1608.

AMERICAN, CANADIAN AND BOURBON

Canadian is distinctive for its light, smooth character thanks to its large percentage of corn spirits. Bourbon, derived from the French Bourbon dynasty, is barrel-aged for its signature sweetness.

ARMAGNAC

Armagnac is a distinctive brandy produced in the Armagnac region in south-west France, from a selection of grape varieties. It is traditionally single distilled in an alembic pot still, and this makes for an initially rough spirit which, with age, becomes earthy, robust and full-bodied.
